Updating the Climate Action Plan to pivot focus to neighborhood resiliency and adaptability

Mary posed the question whether the committee should pivot to focus on neighborhood resiliency and adaptability in light of the pandemic crisis. She discussed her thoughts on the meaning. She pointed out that there seems to be a disconnect among the different parts of the neighborhood. Although 9000 people live in the community, only 1000 persons are on the PPA email list. Responses include consideration of how quickly can our community respond to a crisis; the importance of a robust communication plan so that all in our community can connect; the vital importance of our community being inclusive of all its members, homeowners, renters, and students; and the importance of taking care of our most vulnerable neighbors. We agreed to try to determine the general location of folks who signed up for assistance on the website to determine the needs of the community.
